



How To Expose an Image

1. Picture

To expose an Image, the first thing to do is to reduce it to the smallest enclosing rectangle. You can edit the image in any image editor.

Then drag it into Cenon or use Copy and Paste.

In Cenon, you can scale the image down to the desired size.



2. Draw Path

To create the path you can use Bezier Curves and Lines. In the first step you can roughly place the curves around the contour of the image, and join the single elements into a path. In a second step you can adjust the handles of the Curves to exactly fit the shape of the image.



3. Filled Path

After creating a path you can fill it to see if all parts of the path are connected properly with each other. After you have filled a path, lines will close all open path segments, showing you where fixes are necessary.



4. Join Path & Image

To expose the image with the Path, you select both the Image and the Path. Then go to the 'Edit' menu and click Join (Edit > Join).



5. Result

This is the result of our Exposed Image. The image is floating over the background.
